- Enasay SHG Arbaminch to expand their business open another dry food market sales shop and Siket SHG transmit their product different target area in Arbaminch with networking micro and small scale enterprise office
- Araya cafeteria service cooperative Shashemene benefiting from day today income increment compare to previous period
- Hiwot food preparation cooperative Bahirdar have some progress due to starting new cafeteria service and independently achieve their activities, Elsa&seferash partnership soap cooperative good involvement in soap production IGA
- Aseqwale & Aster general service cooperative Mekelle good performance by using different IGA materials that supported from wise up and woyni &eleni SHG also expand their business in food preparation in addition to dry food IGA
- Mesaley food preparation cooperative Hawassa rent new food and coffee house but little involvement at this quarter
- Ehetemamachoche SHG Asosa built small IGA market house at their previous operational area for better improvement and also Tsinat women cooperative profitable in condom sales including other IGA

- Yetesefa managed general service cooperative Yeka secure working place and open a restaurant that seems profitable at this quarter and members also actively participate in social marketing
- Edeget beheberet food preparation cooperative Ledeta anew started business is attractive but their working place is not permanent for future vision of cooperative
- Habeshaga food preparation cooperative Arada generate income at dic is good but safe and beauty hair salon cooperative poor involvement with lack of unable to cover regular expense

- Hiwot food preparation cooperative Bahirdar participate and provide refereshement for condomize campain in blue Nile ayante hotel
- All wise up office in Addis Ababa and regional site give an alternative IGA opportunities for cooperatives to participate any training, coffe ceremony and safer life event

- Aseqwale & Aster general service cooperative Mekelle and Elsa&seferash partnership soap cooperative Bahirdar actively involve alternative soap production IGA

- Provide and represent individual members to participate condom sales activities
