### **Life skill training by wise up**

Wise up program provide life skill training for newly targeted SHGs to build the capacity of members in running self help groups to become self sufficient and self confidence

### **Participants of trainees**

100 participants of SHG members represent 10 self help groups in Alamata, Adigrat, Dessie, Awash Arba, Wolliso, jimma, Gambella wise up DIC offices for two days in the month of March 2013. The training given by professional micro and small scale experts from government office and additional life skill experts from health office provide theoretical and practical training

### **Problems and lesson learned during the training**

- The training schedule on February but not accomplished because of delay wise up program budget
- Most of trainees are personal & group motivation after training
